



RESOLUTION 2017-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING THE JOHN AND RICHARD CALABRIA PLAN NO. 1 INVOLVING THE SUBDIVISION AND CONSOLIDATION OF TWO (2) LOTS INTO TWO (2) LOTS. THIS SUBMISSION PROVIDES FOR THE TRANSFER OF 36,655 SQUARE FEET OF LAND AREA FROM TAX PARCEL NO. 65-193-0280.006 (JOHN F. AND DONNA M. CALABRIA-1405 AIRPORT ROAD) TO TAX PARCEL NO. 65-193-0281.000 (RICHARD S. CALABRIA-1403 AIRPORT ROAD), IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, on June 23rd, 2017 an application was submitted to Hopewell Township by Richard S. Calabria, to consider the proposed subdivision, known as the John and Richard Calabria Plan No. 1, seeking to subdivide and consolidate two (2) lots into two (2) lots. This submission provides for the transfer of 36,655 square feet of land area from Tax Parcel No. 65-193-0280.006 (John F. and Donna M. Calabria-1405 Airport Road) to Tax Parcel No. 65-193-0281.000 (Richard S. Calabria-1403 Airport Road). Tax Parcel No. 65-193-0280.006 contains a single family residential Unit and Tax Parcel No. 65-193-0281.000 is presently vacant and undeveloped land, and

WHEREAS, the Beaver County Planning Commission rendered its comments in a letter dated June 26th, 2017, and

WHEREAS, on July 14th, 2017, Marie Stratakis Hartman, P.E, Hopewell Township Engineer/ Assistant Manager, issued a comment letter addressing the aforementioned plan citing technical modifications required in order to comport with Hopewell Township Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, November 16th, 2017, (correspondence dated November 29th, 2017) the Hopewell Township Planning Commission recommended approval of the John and Richard Calabria Plan No. 1 application contingent upon compliance with the comments in the Hopewell Township Engineer's letter dated July 14th, 2017 and any comments received from the Beaver County Planning Commission, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hopewell Township Board of Commissioners hereby approves the John and Richard Calabria Plan No. 1 conditioned upon the applicant fully complying with the comments contained in the Hopewell Township Engineer's letter dated July 14th, 2017 and the written recommendations of both the Beaver County Planning Commission and Hopewell Township Planning Commissions prior to recording the Plan with the Beaver County Recorder of Deeds.

Solicitor Mike Jones went over three items. The first was the Blake Meehan continuation of conditional use case already before the BOC and the Planning Commission. Mr. Jones then referenced Resolution 2017-25, which the BOC acted upon at the November 13th, 2017 workshop meeting. This is with regards to making the Park Advisory Board be a recommending body to the Township Board of Commissioners. The resolution is completed and can be recorded. Mr. Jones then addressed the BOC on the e-mail he received from Wendy Dameron, the mother of Boy Scout Chandler Dameron, who has been working in conjunction with the township on building a dog park at Hopewell Park. Mr. Jones said the e-mail dealt with Dog Park monetary donations and the procedure involved in recording the donations for tax record purposes. It was Mr. Jones opinion that the township not be directly involved in the transfer of donations/cash transactions, and rather, Chandler set up a way of accepting and issuing receipts for the cash donations from his end of the project through the Boy Scouts, which already have 501c3 capabilities.

President Bufalini read a letter announcing that a \$95,000 grant had been awarded to Hopewell Township from the Community Conservation Partnerships Program administered by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) from the state of Pennsylvania. The township's intention is to construct an amphitheater at Hopewell Community Park. The letter was a congratulatory letter to the township on being awarded the grant for the Park. Engineer Marie Hartman said that when she does the site process for where the amphitheater will be situated and the core borings are done, she will have the core borings done on Steuer Road at the same time.

President Bufalini also announced that Rosalee Steigerwald, wife of Bob Steigerwald, Hopewell Park Volunteer and contributor to our township in many ways, has passed away. Viewing will be at Tatlovich Funeral Home from 4:00pm-8:00pm on Wednesday.
